

# Medical Field Advisor

**Currently we have a vacancy for a Medical Field Advisor within our innovative and succesful Medical Affairs department.**

The main purpose of the role is to provide *local* medical and scientific support for physicians (mainly influencers), other healthcare professionals (HCPs - nurses, pharmacists, etc) and colleagues in support of business opportunities and strategic objectives taking into account short-, medium-, and long-term local and national business needs

The main outcome of the job is to ensure local HCPs are aware of and understand the scientific basis for and clinical usefulness of our compounds.

## Challenges

The role will be very varied and interesting. You will be responsible for building and maintaining relations with key customers/influencers and major institutions in the health care sector. This also includes actively networking with local healthcare interests in line with current and future business needs.

You will provide quality medical and scientific support, education and training across business area functions to the external customers, healthcare professionals, key opinion leaders and Novo Nordisk staff (where appropriate).

You will be expected to facilitate development of meetings or education seminars for health care providers on subjects relevant to NN products as well as to develop and deliver presentations.

You will optimise on ad hoc opportunities for relevant academic/professional collaboration in the interests of the current and future business needs and develop project proposals in support of a business case for local funding and initiatives.

You will facilitate local Advisory Boards and provide academic contribution before and during the meeting. You will also facilitate publications on Novo Nordisk products, local clinical trials and phase IV studies

You will be required to proactively provide medical support for the local CRD in light of local needs for the development portfolio including identification of sites for clinical trials, assessment of feasibility and patient recruitment through KOL relationships.

**Qualifications**

The successful candidate will have a degree of a Medical Doctor or PhD or other scientific profile. Preferable he/she will have already experience in the pharmaceutical industry. Relevant knowledge of the therapy areas is an added value.

The ideal candidate will have an extravert personality with good presentation and training skills. He/she will have a good knowledge of Dutch, French and English and is IT literated.

The position is 75% field based and the person will report to Dirk D'Hooge, Medical Affairs Director.
